George Morgan is a composer, drummer, percussionist, producer, and pianist who enjoys an active and varied career in St. John's, Newfoundland.

He grew up in Grand Falls, Newfoundland and upon finishing high school moved to St. John's, where he eventually completed a bachelor of music degree (percussion performance) under the tutelage of Don Wherry.

After a year of graduate studies in percussion at the Hochschule für Musik in Würzburg, West Germany, he returned to Newfoundland and started his professional career by joining the legendary band **Figgy Duff**.

For the past twenty years he has been a member of twenty-three bands, been involved with over fifty album recordings, and has toured extensively with **Figgy Duff, The Punters, Pamela Morgan, Wonderbolt Circus, and Joe Keenen**.

In 1998, George started a glamorous singer/songwriter career under the pseudonym **Arthur Capelin**, releasing **Another Planet** in that year and touring Canada in 2001 with **Cock of the Walk**. There are still a few of these discs left in his office.

Recent activities include regular shows with **The Punters, Wonderbolt Circus,** and **The 8 Track Favourites**.

In 2005 George released his album of circus music entitled **WONDERBOLT**.

In October 2007, George released **KNOCKTURNS** for violin (**Alison Black**) and piano (**George Morgan**).
